HOLIDAY CLUB POLICY

Statement of intent

This policy has been implemented to provide clarification of the Lavenham Pre-school Holiday club.

We want children to feel safe, stimulated and happy at Lavenham Pre-school holiday club and feel secure and comfortable with staff. We aim to make the holiday club a welcome place where children settle quickly and easily. Consideration will be given to the individual needs and circumstances of children and their families.

- The holiday club will be offered to all children of Early Years age (3-10 years old).
- The holiday club will run during school holidays as agreed by the Preschool Manager
- The holiday club opening hours are 9.00am – 5.00pm
- Prices are subject to review and change by the Pre-school Trustees.
- Booking is via the Pre-school holiday club booking form and payment must be made in advance.
- Children who have not booked and paid in advance will not be able to attend.
- Any emergency bookings must be made by telephone, Lavenham Pre-school cannot accept children who turn up without a booking.
- Packed lunch in line with our terms and conditions must be provided if the child is staying all day.
- Sessions cancelled or not attended are non-refundable.
